1. Copy of most recent Report Card or evidence of prior grade and school placement. Please note that a student will not be precluded from enrolling due to NYOS's failure to receive transcripts and other academic information requested for enrollment from the student's parents and/or previous school.
2. Copy of Immunization Record – must be up-to-date
3. Copy of TAKS or standardized test results
4. Any legal information that is relevant to the child's well being
5. Two reviews from current or most recent teachers (use provided forms)
