### Test Taking Tips for Parents from Ms. Arles, Elementary Counselor

- Reality Check! It is important to remind children that while the test is important, it is only a part of their complete school evaluation- try to be positive about the test. Try not to show your own anxiety about the test (s).
- Encourage your child to do well without placing too much pressure on them.
- Mark down testing dates so the whole family is aware and can provide support.
- Make certain your child gets a good night's sleep, eats a healthy breakfast (avoid sugary foods and drinks).
- Encourage your child to exercise as often as possible during testing weeks.
