- Melissa Ballentine is fund raising and getting students ready to go on a trip to Washington DC to witness the Presidential Inauguration in January
- 1 Student is currently touring colleges for her bowling scholarship
- First year for NYOS to start a PALs program-sponsored by Bethany Watts
- Sports
  - o Football- high school and middle school teams
  - O Volleyball- high school and middle school teams
  - Cross Country
- 11<sup>th</sup> grade student earned a UT Internship at UT Science
- Project Green just received \$2000.00 grant

Julie Atchley updated the council on facilities.

- Portable were finished prior to 2012 school year start
  - o Portables used for yoga and music
  - o Wooden ramps to the portables and to the parking lot for access to walking track
- Working on renovating building D
- Possibly adding to the Kramer lease to include upstairs for offices
