**Public Comment** 

There was no public comment.

Kathleen Zimmermann presented the emergency declaration for the COVID-19 response, explaining that per legal advice, it was prudent for the Board to issue an emergency executive order. This order waives procurement policies and allows for submission of a waiver for missed instructional days (which will be done at a later date in June). The resolution also authorizes the continuance of pay for employees.
